## Instruction Permits and Learner Licenses



PERMITS USED FOR TRAFFIC EDUCATION				
TEP Traffic Education Permit	AGE*- enrolled in approved traffic education program  *Enrollment age is subject to school policy	DURATION Only during approved traffic education course with traffic education instructor. TEP expires at the end of class	RESTRICTION Drive only with approved traffic education instructor during driver education class	
TELL - Traffic Education Learner License	AGE at least 14 ½ and enrolled in or successfully completed approved traffic education course	DURATION Valid for one year  May use until eligible for Restricted License	RESTRICTION Drive only with traffic education instructor, licensed parent or legal guardian**	

**NOTE: IF PARENTS OR LEGAL GUARDIANS WANT THEIR STUDENT TO DRIVE WITH OTHER ADULTS DURING THE GDL PERMIT PHASE, STUDENTS MUST OBTAIN AN INSTRUCTION PERMIT					
PERMIT AVAILABLE AFTER OR WITHOUT TRAFFIC EDUCATION					
Instruction Permit (IP)/ Learner License	AGE 15 after successful completion of approved traffic education course; or age 16 without traffic education	<b>DURATION</b> Valid for one year	RESTRICTION Drive only with licensed parent, legal guardian or licensed adult driver who is authorized by parent

GDL Restricted	Full Privilege
License	Driver License
BEGINS after student has had any combination of TEP, TELL or IP at least six months AND the student has completed 50 hours of supervised driving practice – 10 hours must be at night with NO traffic, alcohol or drug violations	BEGINS after student has completed one-year GDL restricted license period or if the student turns 18 before the one-year restricted license period is complete, when the student turns 18
<b>DURATION</b> One Year	<b>DURATION</b> EXPIRES ON 21 <sup>ST</sup> BIRTHDAY
GDL RESTRICTIONS -  First 6 months only one unrelated passenger  Second 6 months up to 3 unrelated passengers  Each occupant must wear a seat belt  No driving between 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.  Exceptions to night driving restrictions include emergencies, travel to and from school, church, or work and farm related activities	REMEMBER  Drive Safely  Follow the rules of the road  Everyone wears a seat belt  Drive sober and alert
